The Flight Instructor will be responsible for teaching aviation fundamentals and flight skills to students between the ages of 13-18. The instructor will primarily operate Cessna 150 and Cessna 172 aircraft based at Essex County Airport (KCDW). This part-time position offers a unique opportunity to inspire and mentor young aviators in a non-profit educational setting.

- **Flight Instruction:** Provide comprehensive flight instruction to students, including pre-flight and post-flight briefings, ground school lessons, and in-flight training.
- **Safety:** Ensure the safety of all flight operations, adhering to aviation regulations and best practices.
